Section 1.1 International students admitted via one of the

following English admission pathways ARE REQUIRED to complete the English Language **Enhancement Course**

study, or equivalent, but for less than two years full-time equivalent.

Note these students will be required to complete the ELE course.

This includes:

- a) senior secondary study (including Foundation program studies) or equivalent where the study duration was less than two years;
- b) post-secondary study of a VET Sector accredited certificate, diploma, advanced diploma, or equivalent (eg. TAFE) where the program duration was less than two years;
- c) post-secondary study of a Higher Education Sector accredited diploma (eg. Queensland Institute of Business Technology) where the program duration was less than two years;
- Education Sector accredited associate degree or degree, or equivalent where the study duration was less than two years:
- ix. Satisfactory completion within the past five years of up to two years full-time equivalent post-secondary, Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree- or degree-level study, or equivalent in a country as specified in Schedule A to the Admission Policy for Undergraduate Programs in which the language of instruction and assessment/examination for the entire duration of study was in English;
- x. Satisfactory completion within the past five years of a senior secondary or post-secondary qualification or equivalent from a country other than those specified above, irrespective of the duration of study;
- xi. Satisfactory completion within the past five years from a country other than those specified above of a Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree or degree, or equivalent;
- xii. International students entering through any other English language admission pathways not specified as leading to exemption from completion English of the Language Enhancement Course.

Section 1.2

International students admitted via one of the following English admission pathways are NOT REQUIRED to complete the English Language **Enhancement Course**

study, or equivalent for at least two years fulltime equivalent.

Note these students will not be required to complete the ELE course.

This includes:

- a) senior secondary study (excluding Foundation program studies) or equivalent where the duration of study was at least two years;
- b) post-secondary study where the study duration was at least two years;
- c) VET-Sector accredited certificate, diploma, advanced diploma (eg TAFE) where the combined program duration was at least two years;
- d) A Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree or degree, or equivalent where the study duration was at least two years;
- ix. Satisfactory completion within the past five years of at least two years full-time equivalent post-secondary, Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree- or degree-level study, or equivalent in a country as specified in Schedule A to the Admission Policy for Undergraduate Programs in which the language of instruction and assessment/examination for the entire two years was in English.

Students whose first language is English are not permitted to undertake the English Language Enhancement (ELE) course.

Domestic students whose first language is not English may complete the ELE course as an elective.
